Dear Friends,

It was a huge joy to see St. Paul's church so full on Sunday morning, as our parish weekend at home came to an end with our 5th Sunday joint parish service. Over 100 adults and a dozen or so children were gathered together, which is about 2/3rds of our combined Sunday attendance, and we were able to feast together on God's Word wonderfully taught by Rev Dr Paul Gardner, our speaker for the weekend, and worship God together in song. The morning ended with a sumptuous, shared lunch. There are some pictures further down to enjoy.

I've already had a number of emails remarking on the quality of Paul's Bible teaching, the passion in his delivery and the impact that God's Word has already had. The early chapters in the Letter to the Ephesians are full of glorious gospel truths about the gifts and privileges that are ours in Christ Jesus and the way that God works in our lives as individuals and as a community of believers.
